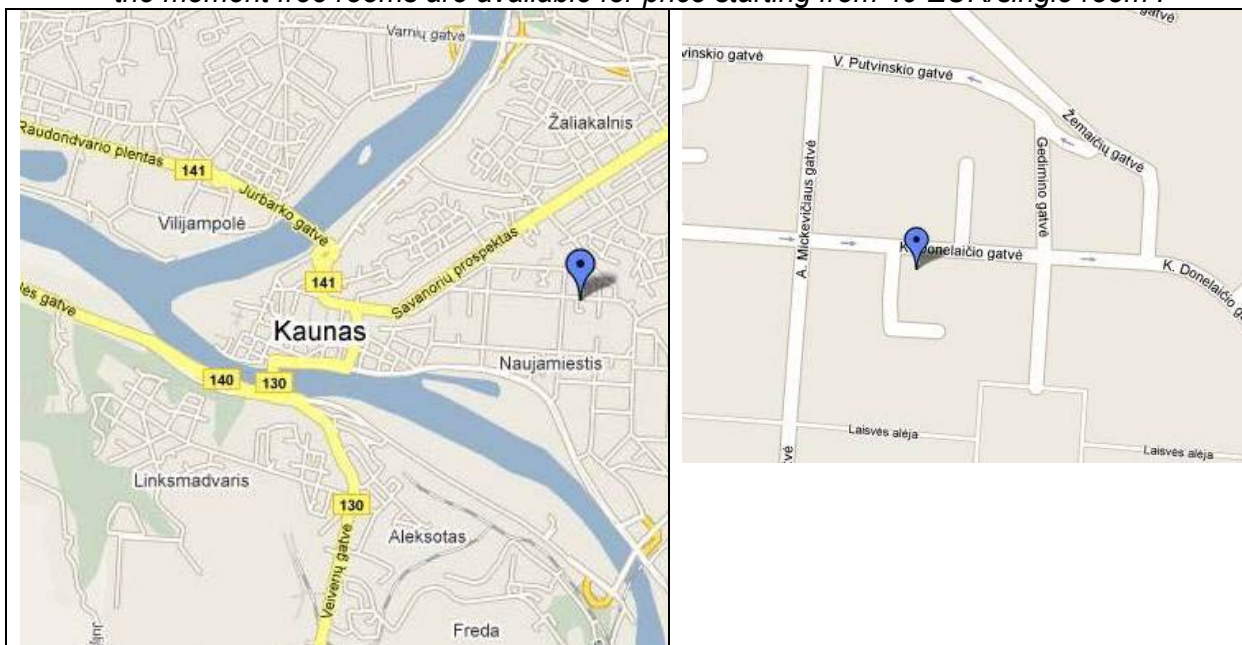

How to reach Kaunas:

The airport transfer can be ordered direct from the hotel. The transfer from Kaunas airport to hotel would cost 60 LTL/car up to six persons, from Vilnius airport 260 LTL/car up to six persons. From Kaunas airport taxi price is approx. 40 – 50 LTL. The public bus is available as well. See: www.kaunas-airport.lt.

One of the best possibilities is to fly through Riga and then three connecting flights a day to Kaunas.

Ryanair has few flights from UK and Ireland and two from Germany – Bremen and Frankfurt.
